### NOTICE OF RACE

The Regatta will be organized by the ESTONIAN DRAGON ASSOCIATION (EDA) in cooperation with Kalev Yacht Club and Pärnu Yacht Club.

### 1. RULES.

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will conform to the current WS Regulation 20 and the Class Rules.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Estonian Cup Series is open to all boats of the Dragon class. The Estonian Cup Series regattas are helmsmen's events and no substitution of helmsman is permitted.

### 4. FEES

4.1. The Entry Fee will be 360€ per boat.

4.2. The entry fee is to be paid to:

# 6. THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be windward-leeward configuration with fleet racing. Spreader marks will and leeward gates may be used. If the windward mark is moved during a race, there will be no spreader mark.

## 7. MEASUREMENTS AND INSPECTIONS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

## 8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

## 9. SCORING

9.1 Individual Event

9.1.1 6 races are scheduled per each Individual Event. 1 race is required to be completed to constitute an Individual Event.

9.1.2 When (a) fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's Individual Event score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's Individual Event score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.2 Overall Cup Series

9.2.1 After each Event, each boat will receive the number of points corresponding to their ranking in that event. The final sum of those points collected during the 3 events, will determine the final ranking.9.2.2 No Events shall be excluded.

10. PRIZES

10.1 The Estonian Cup will be awarded to the helmsman who has won the overall cup series.

10.2 Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be provided for the winning helmsmen and crew of the first three boats of any Individual Event and the Overall Cup Series.

#### 11. INSURANCE

Boats taking part in the races shall have valid adequate third-party insurance.

#### 12. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

#### 13. VENUE

13.1 Venue for "1th &2nd Event" is the Kalev Yacht Club marina and is located at Pirita tee 17, 11911 Tallinn, Estonia.

13.2 Venue for "3rd Event" is the Pärnu Yacht Club marina and is located at Lootsi 6, Pärnu, Estonia.
